As a reward for all their hard work, and as a celebration of their last Christmas in school we are taking all of Year 11 to Basingstoke Ice Rink on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> December 2017.

Students will be allowed to wear warm mufti. Please ensure that the students are wearing **appropriate clothing** to represent the school, with no revealing attire or rude slogans. If anybody does arrive in inappropriate clothing, they will be sent home to change or if there is no time, they will be removed from the trip and sent home.

Pupils will have to bring their own lunch and spending money. Those on Free School Meals will have lunch supplied. If you're interested in your child participating in this school outing, the fee needs to be paid on Parent Pay.

The school budget cannot fund the whole cost of the activity and we are therefore inviting parents to make a payment of £12.00 per child to cover the cost of the coach and admission to the Ice Rink. Students in receipt of Free School Meals may make a payment of £6.00.

Please could students ensure that they are in school for 9.45am ready for a 10.00am departure. Students that travel to school by bus or taxi or need to be dropped off early will be accommodated in school. We will return to school in time for the end of the school day.

By using ParentPay to pay for this trip you automatically give consent for your child to attend, therefore we have not included a reply or consent slip with this letter. **The payment deadline is 6<sup>th</sup> December 2017.** after this date you will not be able to pay for the trip and your child will not be able to attend. If a significant number of parents are unwilling or unable to pay, the activity will be cancelled to prevent the school incurring financial loss. However, the school would not wish to exclude any child from taking part on the grounds of financial hardship. If you cannot afford to make payment this time, please write to The School Business Manager, Mrs Busby, in confidence with a brief explanation of your circumstances.

We very much look forward to celebrating the end of the mock exams with the students.
