Bath Monday 18th December 2017

All year 8 students are going to Bath on Monday 18th December as a reward for all their hard work this term.

Whilst in Bath the students will visit the Roman Baths for an educational tour. They will then be free to participate in some retail therapy and to enjoy the festive spirit in this wonderful city. Students will be allowed to wear mufti. Please ensure that the students are wearing **appropriate clothing** to represent the school, with no revealing attire or rude slogans. If anybody does arrive in inappropriate clothing, they will be sent home to change or if there is no time, they will be removed from the trip and sent home.

Pupils will have to bring their own lunch and spending money for souvenirs/shopping. Those on Free School Meals will have lunch supplied. If you're interested in your child participating in this school educational outing, the fee needs to be paid on Parent Pay.

The school budget cannot fund the whole cost of the activity and we are therefore inviting parents to make a payment of £16.00 per child to cover the cost of the coach and admission. This will include the entry cost to The Roman Baths. Students in receipt of Free School Meals may make a payment of £8.00.

Please could students ensure that they are in the Upper School Car Park for 8.35am. We will depart from School at 8.45am and aim to arrive at Bath for 10.00am. We will be leaving Bath at 3.00pm and should be back at school by 4.20pm, traffic dependent.

Please be aware that although we will endeavour to adhere to timings, unforeseen circumstances may result in a delay to the predicted return arrival time. We will keep parents informed.

By using ParentPay to pay for this trip you automatically give consent for your child to attend, therefore we have not included a reply or consent slip with this letter. **The payment deadline is 8th December 2017,** after this date you will not be able to pay for the trip and your child will not be able to attend. If a significant number of parents are unwilling or unable to pay, the activity will be cancelled to prevent the school incurring financial loss. However, the school would not wish to exclude any child from taking part on the grounds of financial hardship. If you cannot afford to make payment this time, please write to The School Business Manager, Mrs Busby, in confidence with a brief explanation of your circumstances.
