Insight Acceptable Use Agreement

Insight is provided by The Stonehenge School for the use of parents and guardians of students of The Stonehenge School. The overall aim of Insight is to provide further assistance to parents in supporting the students of The Stonehenge School.

The purpose of this agreement is to guide the users of Insight and to protect the rights of all individuals including the safety and well-being of all students.

'By using Insight you will be agreeing to uphold the terms of this Agreement'.

Insight

"Insight" is the parental information internet site hosted by The Stonehenge School. The Stonehenge School and any and all entities that control, are controlled by, or are affiliated or under common control with The Stonehenge School are collectively referred to herein as "we," "us" or "our".

"Users" refers to all other persons that access Insight including the Parent, Student, Staff and Governors of The Stonehenge School.

Accounts

You are required to have a valid account to access Insight . You agree to provide, maintain and update true, accurate, current and complete information about yourself as requested by our registration processes. You shall not impersonate any person or entity or misrepresent your identity or affiliation with any person or entity, including using another person's username, password or other account information, or another person's name, likeness, voice, image or photograph.

You also agree to notify us promptly at admin@stonehenge.wilts.sch.uk of any unauthorised use of your username, password, other account information, or any other breach of security that you become aware of involving or relating to Insight.

We may suspend or terminate your account and your ability to use Insight or feature for failure to comply with these terms of use or any special terms relating to a particular service, for infringing copyright, or for any other reason whatsoever.

Use of Content

Except as we specifically agree in writing, no content from Insight may be used, reproduced, transmitted, distributed or otherwise exploited in any way other than as part of Insight , except that where Insight is configured to enable the download of particular content.

You may download one copy of such content to a single computer for your personal, non-commercial home use only, provided that you (a) keep intact all copyright and other proprietary notices, (b) make no modifications to the content, and (c) do not use the content in a manner that suggests an association with The Stonehenge School . Any business use, "re-mailing" or high-volume or automated use of Insight is prohibited.

In the event that we offer downloads of software on Insight and you download such software, the software, including any files, images incorporated in or generated by the software, and data accompanying the software (collectively, the "Software") are licensed to you by us or third-party licensors for your personal, non-commercial home use only. We do not transfer title to the Software to you. You may not distribute or otherwise exploit the Software or decompile, reverse engineer, disassemble or otherwise reduce the Software to a human-readable form.

Public forums and Communication

"Public Forum" means an area, site or feature offered as part of Insight that offers the opportunity for Users to contribute submissions including chat, message boards, instant messaging, social community environments, profiles, blogs and email.

You acknowledge that contributions/submissions to any Public Forum are publically accessible to all users of Insight and you have no expectation of privacy with regard to any submission to a Public Forum.

You are and shall remain solely responsible for the submissions you distribute on or through Insight under your username or otherwise by you in any Public Forum. Whilst we will make every effort to monitor the Public Forum, we cannot be held responsible for doing so.

Submissions

In these terms of use, we use the word "Submissions" to mean text, messages, ideas, suggestions, photographs, and/or other similar materials that you submit, post, upload, display, communicate or otherwise distribute (collectively known as "Distribute") on or through Insight .

There are two types of Submissions: Solicited Submissions and Unsolicited Submissions. "Solicited Submissions" means those Submissions (a) that we expressly request or enable you to provide to us via any feature or activity on Insight for our review or display, e.g. a survey. "Unsolicited Submissions" are any and all Submissions that do not fall within this above category. By signing this document you agree to not distribute any unsolicited submissions. Submissions may be used and disclosed by us if necessary.

Removal of submissions

We reserve the right, but disclaim any obligation or responsibility, to (a) refuse to post or communicate or remove any Submission from Insight that violates these terms of use and (b) identify any user to third parties, and/or disclose to third parties any Submission or personally identifiable information, when we believe in good faith that such identification or disclosure will either (i) facilitate compliance with laws, including, for example, compliance with a court order, or (ii) help to enforce these terms of use and/or protect the safety or security of any person or property, including Insight . Moreover, we retain all rights to remove Submissions at any time.

Code of Conduct

The following Rules of Conduct apply to Insight. By using Insight, you agree that you will not distribute or contribute any submission that:

- a) is defamatory, abusive, harassing, threatening, or an invasion of a right of privacy of another person;
- b) is bigoted, hateful, or racially or otherwise offensive;
- c) is violent, vulgar, obscene, pornographic or otherwise sexually explicit;
- d) otherwise harms or can reasonably be expected to harm any person or entity;
- e) is illegal or encourages or advocates illegal activity or the discussion of illegal activities with the intent to commit them, including a Submission that is, or represents an attempt to engage in, child pornography, stalking, sexual assault, fraud, trafficking in obscene or stolen material, drug dealing and/or drug abuse, harassment, theft, or conspiracy to commit any criminal activity;
- f) infringes or violates any right of a third party including: (a) copyright, patent, trademark, trade secret or other proprietary or contractual rights; (b) right of privacy; or (c) any confidentiality obligation;
- g) is commercial, business-related or advertises or offers to sell any products, services or otherwise;
- h) contains a virus or other harmful component, or otherwise tampers with, impairs or damages Insight or any connected network, or otherwise interferes with any person or entity's use of Insight ; or does not generally pertain to the designated topic or theme of the relevant Public Forum; violates any specific restrictions applicable to a Public Forum, including its age restrictions and procedures; or is antisocial, disruptive, or destructive, including "flaming," "spamming," and "flooding," as those terms are commonly understood and used on the Internet.
