Potential Expansion of The Stonehenge School, Amesbury

Background

The Stonehenge School needs to expand because of a growing primary school population and new housing being developed in the town. The Wiltshire Core Strategy identifies 2,785 houses to be built in the Amesbury community area by 2026 of which approximately 60% have yet to be completed. The remaining housing is predicted to generate in excess of 300 additional secondary aged pupils and although there is a level of surplus currently it is anticipated that along with the impact of Army Basing expansion of The Stonehenge School will be required.

Forecasts: Red figures show when school reaches/exceeds capacity, indicating that The Stonehenge School will exceed capacity by the academic year 2019.

The proposal

The Stonehenge School Governors and Wiltshire Council are seeking views on a proposal to expand the school from 820 to 1150 students aged 11 to 16. This would start in 2018 with 60 extra students in each age group. The expansion will be funded by the Council from funds provided by the DfE and developer contributions secured by legal agreements as part planning process.

To enable the school to expand it is proposed to provide additional classrooms and learning spaces. Extra teaching and non- teaching staff would be recruited. In developing the plans further, the school will seek to maintain as much as possible of the external play space on site. The accommodation would be built to government requirements and guidelines.









Planning permission for the building works will be required should the proposal proceed.

The views of The Stonehenge School

We have discussed the proposal and support the principle of expansion so that we can help meet the need for school places in the local area. There are disadvantages as well as advantages to expansion and we summarise below some of these. We recognise that this list is not exhaustive and have left space on the attached questionnaire for you to add your views. Should the plans progress we will keep you informed at every stage.

Advantages

- The school would be better able to meet the needs of more of the local community who wish for their children to attend their local school.
- Additional places would be available for children living nearby
- Job creation and greater career progression opportunities for members of staff. The expansion of the school would provide further teaching posts and other related roles from 2018.
- Increased financial flexibility and resourcing for the school.
- New facilities for teaching and learning.

Disadvantages

- The school size will increase, but this will happen incrementally over five years. We will preserve a "family" feel so that students know the staff in their area and don't feel lost.
- Some disruption may occur during the building works on the site and in the local area which would need to be managed very carefully.

What happens next?

- November 2016 consultation starts;
- Early December 2016 deadline for responses to the consultation
- Late December 2016 Stonehenge School considers consultation responses with the Council and both decide whether or not to proceed. Update for parents on progress.
- February 2017 Planning Application
- May 2017 Planning determination
- June 2017 Contractor Starts on Site
- July 2018 Completion and Handover
