All Year 9 Geography students are required to undertake fieldwork activities in the build up to their gcse studies. Students need to practise various data collection techniques in a fieldwork environment as part of their gcse course.

To enable all of the Geography students to excel in this work we will be taking students out of school from 8.45am to 2.50pm on Wednesday 14th June. Students will be travelling to the New Forest to collect primary data on Tourism. Activities such as counting, asking questionnaires, interviews, assessing and photography will take place at a selection of different environments within the New Forest. All students will need to prepare at least one method of gathering data for themselves and complete the tasks their teacher has set them.

We will travel by minibus. Students will need to wear suitable clothing for outdoor fieldwork and bring a packed lunch or money to buy a snack. They should also bring a camera, pencil, pen and clipboard. All Geography students must participate in the fieldwork. Students need to work in pairs and one of each pair must have a wristwatch, as well as a mobile phone. The more work completed the better prepared for passing this aspect of the course. The trip is free of cost.

The trip should be an enjoyable academic activity.
