B) In all cases, The Brilliant Club will process and share personal data about your child in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998. We will ensure all data is held within the EEA, or by companies who are certified to receive data under the EU-US Privacy Shield. The Brilliant Club will process personal data about your child for so long as required to determine the effect of our outreach activity on the educational attainment and progression of our outreach participants from compulsory to post compulsory education and into employment, or for so long as required to do so by law. Under the Data Protection Act 1998, you have the right to be informed about the types of personal data being processed about your child in return for a fee. You also have the right to access, correct and remove the data.
