## Winchester Science Centre Monday 3rd July 2017

Pupils from Key Stage 3 are invited to attend a trip to the Winchester Science Centre and Planetarium on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> July.

We will leave Stonehenge School by coach at 9.20am and return by 2.45pm. Pupils will need to be in school uniform.

The Centre is a huge activity area with a variety of hands on science themed exhibits. Amongst them, the body's hot spots can be seen with thermal cameras, electronic music can be composed and a vortex of water up to 2 metres high can be created. The Planetarium is the largest capacity one in the UK, and has various shows showing digital films with great quality cinema standard sound.

Pupils will have to bring their own lunch and spending money for souvenirs. This trip is limited to a total of 90 pupils and, if you're interested in your child participating in this school educational outing, the fee needs to be paid on Parent Pay.

The school budget cannot fund the whole cost of the activity and we are therefore inviting parents to make a payment of £18.00 per child to cover the cost of the coach, admission and Plantarium show. Students in receipt of Free School Meals may make a payment of £9.00.

By using ParentPay to pay for this trip you automatically give consent for your child to attend, therefore we have not included a reply or consent slip with this letter. **The payment deadline is 19**<sup>th</sup> **June 2017**, after this date you will not be able to pay for the trip and your child will not be able to attend. If a significant number of parents are unwilling or unable to pay, the activity will be cancelled to prevent the school incurring financial loss. However, the school would not wish to exclude any child from taking part on the grounds of financial hardship. If you cannot afford to make payment this time, please write to The School Business Manager, Mrs Busby, in confidence with a brief explanation of your circumstances.

Pupils will be added to the list on a first-paid basis. We will inform you when the list is full.
