Dear Parent/Guardian,

Swanage Wednesday 2nd May 2018

We are organising a day fieldtrip to Swanage on Wednesday 2nd May 2018. The trip is being arranged to conduct fieldwork research for GCSE geography students. In next summers GCSE exam, students are required to answer questions on physical and human geography fieldwork techniques using information gained from practical fieldwork experience. Participation in such activities is a necessity for GCSE geography students.

The trip will take place between 8.35am and 5.00pm and students will be transported by coach to Swanage, where work activities led by teaching staff will take place.

The expectation is for all students from the Year 10 geography class to attend the fieldtrip.

Students will not be required to wear School uniform, however their clothing should be suitable for walking in all weather conditions on uneven surfaces. Students will be expected to follow instructions and conduct themselves in a respectful and civilised manner at all times.

It would be advisable for all students on the trip to bring pen, pencil, clipboard and a packed lunch with them. There is a possibility of purchasing lunch/snacks throughout the day, so a limited amount of money may also be useful. Use of a camera will be needed and students will be expected to undertake some field sketching. Students in each group will also need a phone or watch to check the time.

The school budget cannot fund the whole cost of the activity and we are therefore inviting parents to make a payment of £15.00 per child to cover the cost of the coach. Students in receipt of Free School Meals may make a payment of £7.50.

By using ParentPay to pay for this trip you automatically give consent for your child to attend, therefore we have not included a reply or consent slip with this letter. **The payment deadline is 28th April 2018,** after this date you will not be able to pay for the trip and your child will not be able to attend. If a significant number of parents are unwilling or unable to pay, the activity will be cancelled to prevent the school incurring financial loss. However, the school would not wish to exclude any child from taking part on
