Monkey World Wednesday 24th July 2019

All year 8 students are going to Monkey World on Wednesday 24th July; there is currently no other provision planned in school for that day.

Whilst at Monkey World the students will have access to all of the main attractions at the park. We will get to Monkey World by coach and the whole event will take place within the school day. Students will be allowed to wear mufti. Please ensure that the students are wearing appropriate clothing to represent the school, with no revealing attire or rude slogans. If anybody does arrive in inappropriate clothing, they will be sent home to change or if there is no time, they will be removed from the trip and sent home.

Pupils will have to bring their own lunch and spending money for souvenirs should they wish to purchase any. Those in receipt of Free School Meals will have lunch supplied for them. If you wish for your child to participate in this school outing, the fee is payable via Parent Pay.

The school budget unfortunately cannot fund the whole cost of the activity and we are therefore inviting parents to make a payment of £22.00 per child to cover the cost of the coaches and admission. This will include access to all of the main attractions at Monkey World. Students in receipt of Free School Meals may make a payment of £11.00. By using ParentPay to pay for this trip you automatically give consent for your child to attend, therefore we have not included a reply or consent slip with this letter.

Please could students ensure that they are in the Middle School Car Park/Coach bays by 8.35 a.m. We will depart from School at 9.00 a.m. and aim to arrive at Monkey World for 10.30 a.m.; where we will spend the day enjoying the grounds, primates, other animals and adventure playgrounds. We are aiming to arrive back to school site by 3.00p.m.

Please be aware that although we will endeavour to adhere to timings, unforeseen circumstances may result in a delay to the predicted return arrival time. We will do our utmost keep parents informed.

The payment deadline is 17th July 2019. If a significant number of parents are unwilling or unable to pay, the activity will be cancelled to prevent the school incurring financial loss. However, the school would not wish to exclude any child from taking part on the grounds of financial hardship. If you cannot afford to make payment this time, please write to The School Business Manager, Mrs Busby, in confidence with a brief explanation of your circumstances.
