### Nuffield Campus Theatre, Southampton – 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2020

This year your child is completing the GCSE Drama course. They must see a piece of live theatre to review in the final written exam in May. To meet this requirement of the course, we are organising a trip to see 'I Think We're Alone' by Frantic Assembly at the Nuffield Campus Theatre, Southampton, on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2020.

We will be travelling by coach and will be **leaving school promptly at 5.30pm.** The show will start at 7.30pm and will finish at approximately 9.30pm.

Students must wear full school uniform for safety in the theatre. They may take a small amount of spending money, as there will be the opportunity to buy snacks or they may bring their own snacks but minimal rustling in the theatre please. Mobile phones are allowed on the trip but will have to be turned off before they leave the coach and they can turn them back on again when they are back on the coach.

The school budget cannot fund the whole cost of the activity and we are therefore inviting parents to make a voluntary contribution of £20.00 per child to cover the cost of the coach and the theatre ticket. Students in receipt of Free School Meals may make a payment of £10.00. This will need to be paid on parent pay by Friday 20<sup>th</sup> March 2020 at the latest. Payments not received by then will result in your child not being able to attend this trip.

**Should your child not be able to take up this fantastic opportunity, they will need to go view a piece of live theatre independently to complete the written exam in May.**

If a significant number of parents are unable, or unwilling, to make a voluntary contribution the activity will be cancelled to prevent the school incurring financial loss. However, the school would not wish to exclude any child from taking part on the grounds of financial hardship. If you cannot afford to make payment at this time, please write to the School Business Manager, Mrs Busby, in confidence with a brief explanation of your circumstances.

If you're interested in your child participating in this school educational outing, the fee needs to be paid via Parent Pay.

By using ParentPay to pay for this trip you automatically give consent for your child to attend, therefore we have not included a reply or consent slip with this letter.
