Dear Year 10 parents,

As you will be aware the Prime Minister announced last week that Secondary schools should start to welcome back small groups of Year 10 from 15th June onwards in order to receive some face – to-face support to support their online learning.

We are currently working on plans to ensure that we welcome Year 10 back in accordance with the guidance that has been published:

- One quarter of a year group at a time
- Groups (or social bubbles) of no more than 15
- Staggered start and finish times
- Different areas of the school for social times and lessons
- A curriculum offer that will support their remote learning at home

These plans need to be finalised within the next week (and we will be issuing individualised plans for each student). In order to do this we need to understand your intention regarding a return to school for your child.

In order to secure a place for your child from 15th June it is essential to complete the survey. It is also vital to understand that in order to maximise the safety impact of each bubble, it will not be possible to add students to them at a later date to protect the safety of the students already in that bubble. Therefore we ask that they return at that point only, unless they are isolating due to symptoms.
