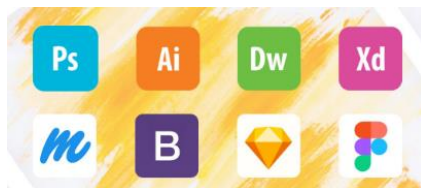

SPRING TERM

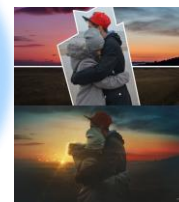
SKILL UP- PHOTOSHOP
