## **Behaviour for Safe Learning**

These guidelines are based on the advice given by the Department for Education and are being implemented for the health, safety and wellbeing of all those in the community.

## IN THE CLASSROOM

- 1. If you are going to cough or sneeze, use a tissue and then put it into the bin when it is safe to do so. If you do not have a tissue, cough or sneeze into the crook of your elbow.
- 2. Minimise contact by staying at your desk or work area.
- 3. Wash your hands regularly and always before eating.
- 4. Use your own equipment do not share.
- 5. You must keep 2 metres distance from your teacher.
- 6. Face masks must remain in your bags at all times.

## **OUTSIDE THE CLASSROOM**

- 1. When you arrive at school, you must go straight to your tutor room via your year group entrance.
- 2. You must use 'common sense' when social distancing from others. This includes when walking or cycling to and from school, as well as when moving around the school.
- 3. Move around school in a calm and sensible manner using allocated routes and entrances/exits.
- 4. Toilets are allocated to your year group. You should only use these toilets. If they are busy you should wait before entering.
- 5. Throughout the day you must stay within your year group areas.
- 6. At the end of the day you must wait in the designated area for your transport or leave the school grounds promptly.

Any deliberate coughing or sneezing at people as a "joke" will result in an exclusion.
