



Behaviour for Safe Learning

These guidelines are based on the advice given by the Department for Education and are being implemented for the health, safety and wellbeing of all those in the community.

IN THE CLASSROOM

1. If you are going to cough or sneeze, use a tissue and then put it into the bin when it is safe to do so. If you do not have a tissue, cough or sneeze into the crook of your elbow.
2. Minimise contact by staying at your desk or work area.
3. Wash your hands regularly and always before eating.
4. Use your own equipment - do not share.
5. You must keep 2 metres distance from your teacher.
6. Face masks must remain in your bags at all times.

OUTSIDE THE CLASSROOM

1. When you arrive at school, you must go straight to your tutor room via your year group entrance.
2. You must use 'common sense' when social distancing from others. This includes when walking or cycling to and from school, as well as when moving around the school.
3. Move around school in a calm and sensible manner using allocated routes and entrances/exits.
4. Toilets are allocated to your year group. You should only use these toilets. If they are busy you should wait before entering.
5. Throughout the day you must stay within your year group areas.
6. At the end of the day you must wait in the designated area for your transport or leave the school grounds promptly.

Any deliberate coughing or sneezing at people as a "joke" will result in an exclusion.
