We focus on exposing students of every year group to professional theatre, the more they see, the more they know! This has previously included theatre visits and backstage tours to experience non-performance job roles in the theatre.

We host 'Stage 65' Drama club on Tuesdays at 15:30pm. Any student in school is welcome to attend, especially those who choose not to opt for GCSE Drama – it is open to all!

We are fortunate enough to benefit from Theatre specialists who come into school to run master classes in; costume design, producing theatre, creative writing and technical lighting and sound.



We aim to offer every Stonehenge pupil the chance to get involved with the whole school show, this can be as a performer, technical assistant (of which



there are many) or front of house. Past whole-school productions have included; The Hobbit, The Time Machine, St Trinian's, High School Musical; Cabaret, A Christmas Carol, Annie, Oliver, My Fair Lady; Alice in Wonderland, Bugsy Malone and Grease.

We also seek to host workshops from professional theatre companies to further instil a passion for creativity while students explore new and exciting techniques. Our most recent workshop featured Splendid Theatre's Kerry Frampton working with our year 9 and 10 Drama students on their devising skills.

We are also lucky to receive offers from industry professionals in various roles who come into school to give talks to students to explain their roles and skills needed to succeed in daily challenges in the place of work.

We have links with National Drama who work with our students and champion their voice to a nation-wide audience, this is through their play reviews and discussing what Drama means to them.
