Extra Curricular

Maths lends itself to a number of extra-curricular activities and opportunities to see the subject in action, outside of the classroom.

UKMT – Students in Year 7-10 take part in this maths competition every year.

GCSE Astronomy – Mr Selwood runs GCSE Astronomy after school for students in Year 9 and Year 10.

Visits to Intech; Winchester Science Museum – This excellent museum lets students experiment with a range of scientific and mathematical ideas, and the planetarium talk stresses the links between maths and science.

Maths Days – Over the years we have run a huge variety of Maths Days – encouraging students to explore maths in different contexts. World Trading Games, visiting guests with problem solving questions, art projects (see below) numbers from around the world as well as examining the excellent films *The Imitation Game* and *Hidden Figures*.



We have taken part in the first two Wessex partnership ‘maths feasts’ at Sarum Academy. These are aimed at students in Year 7 who might see maths as a challenging subject but nevertheless we believe can enjoy success and experience the same wonder of maths as traditionally more able students.
