We would like to invite your child to our Year 5/6 Taster Day 2021.

Please use our new entrance on Holders Road to access our school site. The day will begin at 8.45 am, with the students meeting in the Atrium in our new building. Members of staff will be at the new school entrance to help direct your child to the right place.

Students should wear their Primary School uniform and bring basic equipment such as pen , pencil etc. Lunch will be provided but you may wish to provide your child with a break time snack.

If your child needs to take any medication during the day please could you call the school office and ask for Mrs S Hoult office manager who will discuss your needs and if we can accommodate.

Students will be available for collection at 2.30pm which is the end of our school day from the Atrium in our new build. There is limited parking in front of the building.

The aim of the day is to give the pupils a chance to see and experience our school during a normal working day. We have limited each session to pupils coming from one school each day. You will have booked your child into these sessions but probably for another date, but due to covid rules being extended, we cannot have mixing of schools. This is the nearest we can achieve to a normal taster day.

Pupils will experience 5 lessons during the day and will be accompanied by a member of our Pastoral team and Ta's throughout the day.

We have endeavoured to call all parents to let them know ,but we are also asking our primary feeders to help us communicate this information out to parents.

We can only accept pupils who were already booked in for the taster day.
