Dear Parents / Carers,

It has been another extraordinary year. As we have said frequently to the students, when the history books are written in the future both 2020 and 2021 will feature prominently. As previously announced in May, during the academic year 2021 to 2022, we will be joint coheadteachers of The Stonehenge School working together to ensure all of our pupils are provided with the provision they need to build successful futures. 5. School uniform, PE kit and hairstyles

At the start of this letter I stated that September should mark a return to 'business as usual'.
