Charity Walk – 1st October 2021

As Covid restrictions are eased and schools return to normal, we are delighted to be able to re-introduce the Annual Charity Walk which has been a Stonehenege School fixture for over 50 years. This year all monies raised will go to the Macmillan Cancer Support charity. This charity was chosen by the School Parliament as our charity for the year and is a most worthy cause.

Arrangements for the day

School transport will run as usual; students must wear school PE kit to enable us to identify them quickly. They may wear plain black leggings or tracksuit bottoms and bring a hoody and a waterproof coat. In the event of adverse weather the event will be postponed – we will keep you updated by Schoolcomms.

The walk is approximately 7 miles. The day allows students to spend time with their peers and teachers, talk to one another and enjoy the natural environment we are lucky to have in Wiltshire. The benefits of exercise and fresh air on physical and mental health are well known. Students must bring adequate and suitable food and drink. Students entitled to Free School Meals will be provided with a packed lunch and a drink. Fresh drinking water will be available at the break and lunch stops.

Students are able to return home as soon as they have registered upon arrival at the school. **ALL STUDENTS MUST REGISTER IN SCHOOL UPON COMPLETION OF THE WALK**. Studfents who return home by bus or taxi can be accommodated in school until 2.50 pm.

The walk is a whole day activity and involves all staff. There is therefore no provision available in school that day.

The cost of the walk/charity donation is £1, payable in cash on the day in registration. If you or your family wish to reward your child's efforts with additional donations these will be gratefully received but we must stress this is not a sponsored event and pupils must not collect money door to door.
