## Mayflower Theatre, Southampton – 27th January 2022

We are running a school trip to the Mayflower Theatre on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> January 2022 to see the incredible 'The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time' by Frantic Assembly. The production contains strobe lighting, smoke and haze effects, high intensity video and light effects and loud sound effects.

The show starts at 2pm so we aim to leave school via coach promptly after lesson 3 has ended. Students are required to bring a packed lunch with them to eat on the coach. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals, they will have their lunch provided by the school. They may also bring money to purchase snacks in the theatre should they wish. Correct school uniform must be worn for the easy identification of our students. Anyone without the correct uniform will not be allowed to attend and any poor behaviour will potentially affect future trips.

Mobile phones are allowed on the trip but must be switched off once in the theatre. The show has an approximate running time of 2 hours 30 minutes so we aim to be back at school between 17:30 and 17:45.

There are 51 tickets available to Drama students in years 9, 10 and 11. Tickets will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

The school budget cannot fund the whole cost of the activity and we are therefore inviting parents to make a voluntary contribution of £27.00 per child to cover the cost. Students in receipt of Free School Meals may make a payment of £13.50. This will need to be paid on parent pay by  $25^{th}$  January 2022 at the latest. Payments not received by then will result in your child not being able to attend this trip.

If a significant number of parents are unable, or unwilling, to make a voluntary contribution the activity will be cancelled to prevent the school incurring financial loss. However, the school would not wish to exclude any child from taking part on the grounds of financial hardship. If you cannot afford to make payment at this time, please write to the School Business Manager, Mrs Wakeham, in confidence with a brief explanation of your circumstances.









If you're interested in your child participating in this school educational outing, the fee needs to be paid via Parent Pay.

By using ParentPay to pay for this trip you automatically give consent for your child to attend, therefore we have not included a reply or consent slip with this letter. The payment deadline is 25<sup>th</sup> January 2022, after this date you will not be able to pay for the trip and your child will not be able to attend.

We look forward to this exciting show after a long wait!
