Poetry Live!- Bath, Monday 7th February 2022

Your son/daughter has been invited to take part in the English Department's trip to the **Poetry live!** Event at The Forum, Bath on **Monday 7th February 2022**.

This is an excellent opportunity for your child to hear the poems they are studying for GCSE to be read by the poets themselves, and can add strongly to their understanding of the Poetry Anthology. For more information about the performance, please visit:

There are limited tickets available, so they will be issued on a first-come, first-served basis. We regret that refunds cannot be made unless the visit is cancelled by the school. The coach will leave school at 9.00am, and we aim to return by 4.30pm.

The cost of the trip, including coach travel, will be **£25**.

The school budget cannot fund the whole cost of the activity and we are therefore inviting parents to make a voluntary contribution of £25.00 per child to cover the cost. Students in receipt of Free School Meals may make a payment of £12.50. This will need to be paid on parent pay **by Friday 21st January 2022** at the latest. This is the deadline from Poetry Live! Limited and payments not received by then will result in your child not being able to attend this trip.

If a significant number of parents are unable, or unwilling, to make a voluntary contribution the activity will be cancelled to prevent the school incurring financial loss. However, the school would not wish to exclude any child from taking part on the grounds of financial hardship. If you cannot afford to make payment at this time, please write to the School Business Manager, Mrs Wakeham, in confidence with a brief explanation of your circumstances.

Students must wear full school uniform and bring a packed lunch with them as there will be no opportunities to buy food on the day. Students who are entitled to Free School Meals will have their lunch provided by the school. Mobile phones are allowed on the trip but must be switched off once in the theatre.

If you're interested in your child participating in this school educational outing, the fee needs to be paid via Parent Pay.



By using ParentPay to pay for this trip you automatically give consent for your child to attend, therefore we have not included a reply or consent slip with this letter. The payment deadline is **Friday 21st January 2022**, after this date you will not be able to pay for the trip and your child will not be able to attend.
