### Year 10 V&A Trip 24<sup>th</sup> June 2022

As part of Year 10's GCSE Art & Design Coursework Project (Art, Textiles & Photography) we will be taking students to the Victoria and Albert Museum in London on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> June 2022. This includes a visit to the exhibition called Fashioning Masculinities, which is in addition to the main galleries within the V&A.

This will give students a great opportunity to get primary research for their developing projects.

We will be leaving school at 8.30am and we will return to school and release students at the new building entrance at 5.30pm.

Students will be required to wear school uniform. It would also be advisable for students to bring a coat, a small sketchbook, drawing pencils and a packed lunch, and a little money for any trinkets they may like to purchase at the gift shop. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals then a packed lunch will be provided by the school. Also, it will be useful if your child could bring a fully charged phone, so they can take pictures of artwork on the trip.

The school budget cannot fund the whole cost of the activity and we are therefore inviting parents to make a payment of £20.00 per child to cover the cost of the coach & the exhibition.

The cost of the students in receipt of Free School Meals may make a payment of £10.00.

By using Parent Pay to pay for this trip you automatically give consent for your child to attend, therefore we have not included a reply or consent slip with this letter. **The payment deadline is the 17<sup>th</sup> June 2022.**

After this date you will not be able to pay for the trip and your child will not be able to attend.

If a significant number of parents are unwilling or unable to contribute, the activity will be cancelled to prevent the school incurring financial loss. However, the school would not wish to exclude any child from taking part on the grounds of financial hardship. If you cannot afford to make payment this time, please write to The School Business Manager, Mrs Wakeham, in confidence with a brief explanation of your circumstances.
