Dear parents and carers,

Re: Change to the length of the school day

Following our consultation earlier in the year, and based on the limited number of responses we received during the consultation stage, the Governing body of The Stonehenge School have made the decision to change the school day from 1st September 2023.

They have therefore agreed to extend the school day from 1st September 2023. The timings of the school day with therefore be -

School will start at 8:30am and then finish at 3pm

These changes will be beneficial to the school community in a range of ways, and will have a positive effect on your child's education. Due to the rapid increase of the school we currently have two lunch times, of 30 minutes each, meaning that registration time in tutor groups is also 30 minutes long, causing lesson time to be cut throughout the day.

The change in the school day, combined with an increase in catering facilities and undercover eating areas will mean that we can move to staggering lunchtime slightly, and use the additional 15 minutes a day to extend breaks and lunch times for the pupils. The time gained will then be added back on to learning time so that all lessons move back to being exactly one hour long.
