Despite comfortably winning the event with what would have been a new course record (which dates back to the 1970s!) and only a second off National Entry standard time Henry was unfortunately deemed to have touched the line during the race and as a result was disqualified after the race. This is certainly a learning curve for Henry and as frustrating as it may be, we fully expect Henry to bounce straight back and put in a stellar performance in Exeter tomorrow.
