Day format and catering options:

Dear Students and Parents/Carers,

We are thrilled to continue with our new format for our annual Sports Day, now called the Sport Festival, designed to involve and engage more students in a wider variety of activities. Considering our school's increasing size and rising costs, we have revamped the Sport Festival to ensure it continues to be a key event in our school calendar.

Venue and Format

This year, the Sport Festival will take place at Holders Road Playing Fields, our secure and well-maintained grounds. This new format enables us to provide a variety of activities that appeal to a broader spectrum of interests, encouraging more students to take part and enjoy the activities.

Event Details:

- **All year groups:** Tuesday, 22nd July.
- **Registration & P1:** With tutor completing house activities
- **10:00 – 14:30:** Holders Playing Fields.

Students will compete in House tournaments/events (athletics, touch rugby and rounders) and choose from various festival activities (see next page) in specially designated areas.

Important Information:

- Students are required to wear their school PE kit; failure to do so by wearing the incorrect kit will result in disqualification from participation
- Students must attend morning registration as usual and will remain at Holders for the duration.
- We recommend bringing caps, suntan lotion, and plenty of water.
- Each student will receive one bottle of water.
- An ice cream van will be on-site, and in response to student feedback, there will also be food stalls featuring a burger and hotdog van and a mobile coffee van.
- Please ensure your child brings any necessary medication, such as asthma inhalers, to the event.

Food Options

Food available on Sports Festival

We have a variety of food vans on Holders Field on the day where food such as burgers and ice-creams can be purchased **or** your child can pre-order a sandwich bag on ParentPay if they would prefer a cold lunch. Alternatively, you can send your child with a packed lunch.

Hot Food

We have **Dinky Diner** providing Hot dogs @ £3.00, Burgers @ £3.50 or a Vegetarian burger @ £3.50. They will also have a selection of cold drinks and confectionary on sale.

H's Ices will be providing various ice creams ranging from £2.00 up to £3.50

Rozzie Coffee will be providing various hot and cold drinks ranging from £1.70 to £3.50.

These can be purchased on the day with cash or a debit card.

Cold Food

You just need to choose which bag your child would like (Sandwich Bag 1, 2 or Baguette bag) and make payment on ParentPay. Once purchased your child will receive a form to choose their choice of sandwich etc.

Sandwich Bag – Cost £2.60

- Sandwich – Chicken mayo, tuna mayo, ham or cheese
- Cake - Shortbread
- Drink - plain water bottle

Baguette bag – Cost £4.00

- Baguette – Ham, ham and cheese, chicken and bacon mayo, chicken tikka, tuna and cucumber or cheese
- Cake – Brownie, flapjack or iced sponge
- Pop chips
- Drink - plain water bottle

A cold lunch must be pre-ordered prior to sports day. You will be able to purchase on ParentPay until the end of the day on Tuesday 15th July.

→ FSM Students may choose to order a Sandwich Bag or a token to use for a burger or hotdog. A form will be sent shortly for you to place this order.
