Spiritual education at the Stonehenge School in MFL concerns students comparing and contrasting festivals and customs in the UK and the target language countries. Students also use creativity, imagination and reflection in their speaking and writing work.

Moral education at The Stonehenge School in MFL concerns students taking a stance on more controversial social issues. They also are required to understand a range of points of view on a number of topics.

Social education in the Stonehenge school in MFL concerns promoting tolerance and learning to communicate with people from different backgrounds.

Cultural education at the Stonehenge School in MFL involves students developing an appreciation of different ways of life.

Examples of Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural Education in **Modern Foreign Languages** include:

- Looking at the festivals like Christmas and Easter and learning how they are celebrated in France, Germany and Spain.
- Writing poems and short stories in the target language which involve students in using their imagination and / or reflecting on their own experiences.
- Reading problem pages, school rules etc. which help students develop a sense of right and wrong.
- Taking part in cultural experiences such as French breakfasts, visits abroad, theatre visits which allows students to deepen their understanding of other ways of life.
- Working in a variety of settings i.e. pair work, group work role play debating etc.
