Welcome to The Stonehenge School. We wanted to take this opportunity to say we are very pleased that your child will be joining us this September.

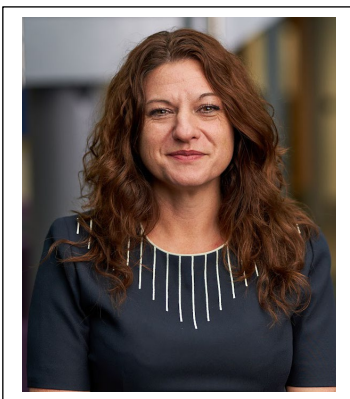
